18 October - The Terengganu state government, was honoured to receive an invitation to an investor meeting with Former Prime Minister, Tun Dr Mahathir bin Mohamad and Terminus Group, a Chinese investor, to discuss the investment opportunities for the state, held at Putrajaya.
